Information for Applicant Groups

Thames Community Foundation was founded in 1990 as Richmond Community Trust and became known as Thames Community Foundation in 1997. The current area of benefit covers the boroughs of Hammersmith & Fulham, Hounslow, Kingston, Merton, Richmond, Sutton and Wandsworth.

The aim is to raise money from local sources to meet local needs.

No charitable work can exist in isolation and we hope to act as a catalyst towards an active partnership between local charities and the business community in the area.

The Foundation wishes to reflect the needs and priorities of people living in its area of benefit and to support, in particular, small neighbourhood organisations.

Current Priorities:

- Addiction
- Adults with Disabilities
- Children and Young People
- Welfare

In general, priority may be given to new applications from local voluntary and community groups, including registered charities, who may be applying for a grant for the first time.

Exclusions:

Applicants should note that Thames Community Foundation is unable to support any of the following:

- Projects led by statutory bodies such as schools or local authorities
- Research
- Major capital costs of the refurbishment of buildings
- Minibuses
- Animal welfare
- Promotion of religious or political causes
- National appeals
- General and unspecified contributions to costs
- Activities which are for commercial gain
- Activities which benefit only one person or family
- Activities which benefit people living outside the Foundation's area of benefit

Please note also that only properly constituted voluntary or community groups or registered charities may apply. We cannot accept applications from private individuals.
